HOW TO GET THERE

By tram: Catch the free City Circle Tram or the following city trams: 30 via LaTrobe Street, 31 via Collins Street, 48 or 70 via Flinders Street or 86 via Bourke Street.

By train: Take the train to Southern Cross Station and walk over the Bourke Street Pedestrian Bridge to Harbour Esplanade.

By car: Pay parking facilities available at the rear of Digital Harbour on Harbour Esplanade, at Telstra Dome, along Docklands Drive at NewQuay and Waterfront City, also along Bourke Street and North Wharf Road.

By bike: The Yarra Trail, the Capital City Trail, Moonee Ponds Creek Trail and the Maribyrnong Trail all converge at Docklands.
